

TIPS FOR SUCCESSFUL TASTING

LOOK

When wine tasting, the first step is to take time to look at the wine, especially around the edges. Look for the color of the wine and the clarity. This is why clear glasses should be used for tasting wine.

SWIRL

Swirl the wine in your glass. This is done to mix oxygen in with the wine, which will soften the tannins of young wine. It also opens up the flavors and aromas of the wine.

SNIFF

Sniff the wine. Initially you should hold the glass a few inches from your nose. Then let your nose go into the glass. What do you smell?

SIP

Take a sip of the wine, but do not swallow yet. Roll the wine around in your mouth exposing it to all of your taste buds. Do this for at least a few seconds while thinking about the tastes of the wine.

SWALLOW

Swallow the wine. How long does the "finish" last? How long can you taste the wine after you swallow? Do you like the tastes?

HAVE FUN!

Tasting wine is supposed to be fun. Don't stress about doing everything exactly right. Don't worry if your tastes are different than people around you. Everyone has their own tastes.

In this small farming community nestled along the Sacramento River, the Bogle family's years of hard work have developed into an impressive grape growing operation, as well as a nationally acclaimed winery.

Today Bogle Vineyards farms over 1,200 acres of wine grapes in the Delta region. While the winery was established ten years after the first grapes were planted, its success has grown tremendously along with the vineyards.

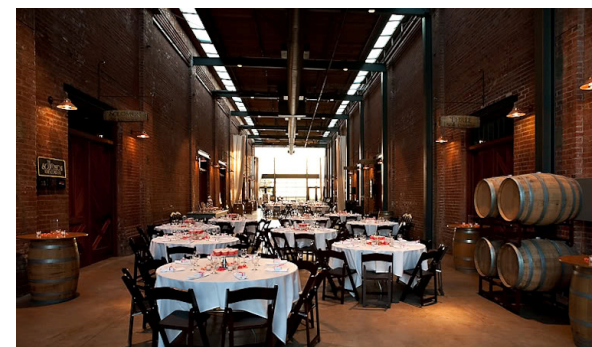
